Jefferson County, pop. 30,000, is located on the Olympic Peninsula in western Washington. Port Townsend is the only incorporated city in the county and is the county seat. Port Townsend is a spectacular Victorian seaport designated as a National Historic Landmark and famous for its Victorian Homes Tour, and Wooden Boats and Rhododendron Festivals. The PUD is served by a board of three elected commissioners.

Reporting to the Electrical Operations Manager, the Electrical Engineer provides engineering services, through analysis for internal and external District customers, including system protection and coordination, load allocations, staking, system optimization, fault study, communication and automation, in compliance with District policies and applicable government standards. Candidates must have knowledge in RUS construction standards and System of accounts, and should have knowledge of NESC, NEC, and IEEE.

This position requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in electrical engineering, or a closely related field. Candidates must have a minimum of six (6) to ten (10) years progressively responsible experience in utility or power engineering. Candidates must have Washington State PE or the ability to obtain one in 6 months from hire date.
